
A BOX OF BOOKS BY JACK SPICER WITH FORGERIES BY RICHARD DENNER

The Collected Books of Jack Spicer, edited and with a commentary by Robin Blaser (Black Sparrow Press, Santa Rosa, 1975) includes all the poems written from *After Lorca* (1957) up to the poet's early death (1965), including Admonitions (1958), *Billy the Kid* (1958), *A Red Wheelbarrow* (1959?), *Heads of the Town Up to the Aether* (1960-1961), and *Book of Magazine Verse* (1966).

Richard Denner met Jack Spicer at the Berkeley Poetry Conference in 1965. Sitting with Jack in a car on Blake Steet, he asked for pointing out instructions, and after receiving a mind transmission on the nature of poetry he proceeded to produce serial poems in chapbook form. This artbook was created on September 5, 2022 in Ellensburg, Washington.


At the 1965 Berkeley Poetry Conference, the brilliant poet Jack Spicer gave a particularly poor lecture, and shortly thereafter was rushed to the hospital, where he died ten days later, on August 17th, of alcohol-related illnesses...Richard Denner was twenty-three when he attended the 1965 Conference. Jack Spicer was not the only famous poet he met. He was not the only famous poet who applauded Richard's work. He was the only famous poet there who applauded Richard's work and died a few days later. These things happen. Not very often, but they happen.


D Press, Sebastopol, California, 2003, Cover by S. Mutt






