



### **COLOPHON**

Richard Denner's PRIMAL BOOK was constructed from two notebooks with added detritus assemblage, circa 1988, after the author's nervous breakdown due to excessive drug and alcohol use, following a breakup with Beryl Reeves, the most the most beautiful woman in the world, a part she had played in Dan Herron's movie Red Hanharan, based on William Butler Yeat's short story of that name. It was at this time, Richard received a mind transmission from Sogyal Rinpoche and entered the Vajrayana Path, later to become the monk, Jampa Dorje. The "Certificate of Authority" and the "Rrose Sélevy Appraisal" were added for a Gallery One art show in Ellensburg, Washington, in 2020. This colophon was written in 2022 at the time of the book being donated to the High Mountain Valley Local Authors Collection in Brooks Library at Central Washington University. Now completed, thank the tutelary gods that be.
